In 2019 Europe celebrates the 30th anniversary of the historical events of 1989, when the Iron Curtain fell.

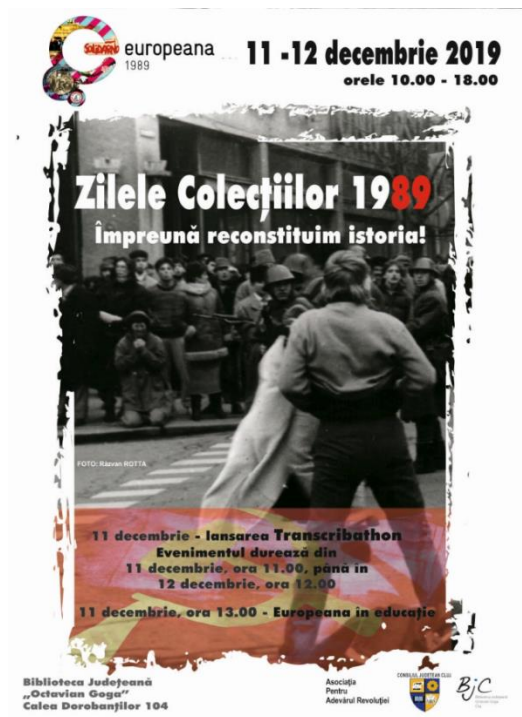

Europeana Collection Days, Cluj-Napoca, December 2019

During the **Europeana 1989 Collection Days**, a number of documents and personal stories were gathered from people who lived in that time or from their successors. There were digitized and described 138 objects, among which there were: photographs, newspapers, posters, cards, notebooks, journals, booklets, albums, toys, symbolic objects, decorations, awards.



The **Transcribathon** had as objective the transcription of some of the documents collected by the library at the activity held in July this year (the first edition of the Europeana 1989 Collection Days). Eight people participated in this competition, divided into four teams.
